The roads ahead

The next steps should occur in the following order (presumed):

1 _ IPHAN appoints a Technical Committee to prepare a dossier for the nomination. This committee should be comprised of people responsible for these heritage assets, municipal and state governments, and other institutions or professionals that can contribute to the preparation of the dossier and the nomination process;

2 _ After review and approval by the Brazilian government, the dossier will be sent to the UNESCO Heritage Center;

3 _ If the dossier is accepted by UNESCO, ICOMOS/ICOFORT _ www.icofort.org _ will conduct the analysis through its active members (experts in fortifications, in this case);

4 _ ICOFORT will designate three (3) experts _ one of whom will come to Brazil for on-site evaluation, with the participation of the Technical Committee and the team which prepared the dossier. This assessment may include recommendations and steps to be taken; and,

5 _ The three ICOFORT experts will issue a (base) report for the UNESCO World Heritage Committee to include or not include the forts on the Brazilian government's Tentative List.
