



Colonial Fort Circuit/Scouts 10 editions - 2014

An "ever alert" vanguard composed of scouts from the Baixada Santista metropolitan region participated in a proposal called *Heritage Education - Fort Circuit/Scouts*, which began on March 29, 2014.

The educational project was supported by the **Guarujá** and **Santos** secretaries of culture, by **Santos Pilotage** and by **Lanches Fabiana**, once a month through December 2014.

The tourist and cultural tour consisted of one of the legs of the **Fort Circuit**, involving a visit to the Casa do Trem Bélico (1734); a hike to the Customs Office in Santos, where Fort Nossa Senhora do Monte Serrat once stood (1543); a maritime route through the port of Santos, including the port terminals and the Vera Cruz de Itapema Fortress (1738); and finally, a visit to the Santo Amaro Fortress in Barra Grande (1584), the most significant military architecture ensemble in the state of São Paulo.
